



GIJO Judges Info Sheet

Although the GIJO routines are the same as USAG, there are a few differences in the judging:

-The gymnasts are not timed on beam, for falls on bars, or on floor routines.

-Do not go below a 5.0

-Only take the .5 deduction for a spot, do not take the value of the skill plus the .5.

-Do not judge as strict as USAG, but please make sure the gymnasts are properly placed.

-If the gymnast goes out of bounds on floor, do not deduct the .1, there is no deduction.

-If an Optional gymnast's coach goes on the floor during her routine, there is no deduction.

There is no jewelry deduction.

-If you do not know the deductions, they are in the back of the compulsory book, if you do not have one, ask the host of the meet or email me (Jenny Cacchione) at AEgymnast22@aol.com & I will email/fax it to you.

-Judges receive \$60 per session or \$1 per gymnast, whichever is more.

-If a gymnast forgets her routine, she can stop & start it all over again with a 2.0 deduction.
